

The Idaho Society of CPAs Scholarship Fund is now accepting applications for scholarships for the 2010-2011 academic year. Scholarships from the fund benefit college juniors and seniors majoring in accounting at an Idaho college or university.

ISCPA will award a maximum of three, individual \$1,000 scholarships for the 2010-2011 academic year and will notify recipients in May.

Eligibility:

Idaho resident

Majoring in Accounting

Enrolled as a full-time student at the junior or senior level (third or fourth year) at a college or university in the state of Idaho

Must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.75 or above for all class work prior to the application

Non-traditional students who have not been enrolled in a higher education institution for a period of three years shall be exempt from the cumulative grade point average requirement for the first semester, or quarter, of the scholarship.

All recipients must maintain the stated grade point for each semester the scholarship is in effect

Deadline:

Completed applications, transcripts and recent grades must be date-stamped by midnight on April 11, 2010.
