Preface:

Participating faculty members are actively engaged in the life of our college in matters beyond direct teaching responsibilities. Our college considers these faculty members to be long-term members of the faculty regardless of their current teaching loads, their titles, or contract length. The college recognizes a wide-range of non-teaching activities in which faculty members may be engaged but expects each participating faculty member to be involved with at least one of the following specific activities.

Interaction with Students

- Serves as an academic advisor
- Mentors student interns
- Serves as a faculty advisor to student groups
- Serves as a guest speaker in other professors' courses

Participation in Discipline, Department, and College Activities

- Develops, offers, and maintains new courses
- Contributes to program enhancements
- Attends discipline meetings
- Attends department meetings
- Attends the meeting of or is a member of the department's advisory board
- Serves on committees as appropriate
- Attends College of Business and Economics meetings
- Interacts with faculty and alumni at alumni events

Participation in Professional Activities and Research

- Has a research agenda or participates in research collaboratively
- Interacts with faculty and professionals at professional or academic meetings

Faculty members serving as EMBA course coordinators qualify as Participating due to their in-depth participation in EMBA course and curriculum development as well as their active participation in delivering the courses.
