### REQUIREMENTS for GENERAL BUSINESS MAJORS

1. I understand that the “Finish in Four” guarantee for the degree is for the BBA only, not the BA or BS. I will maintain my BroncoWeb records and checklists to reflect the BBA degree.
2. I will enroll in the appropriate courses needed for my degree program on the same day as my designated registration appointment.
3. I will resolve any issues that may prohibit registration prior to the date of my designated registration appointment (including, but not limited to, securing financial aid, paying fines, and resolving judicial issues). My ability or inability to obtain financial assistance does not affect the terms of the Agreement.
4. I understand that specific courses may not be available at the time or in the semester in which I would prefer to take them. I agree that if any section of the course needed for my degree program is open that course is considered available, and I will register for it.
5. Should there be **no** open sections of a course needed for my degree program I will notify my advisor and the “Finish in Four” Coordinator, in writing with complete contact information, the same day of designated registration appointment.
6. I understand that substitutions for required courses in the College of Business and Economics are unlikely to be available and/or approved.
7. I will maintain my own records of this agreement and any program requirements or changes that may be made to this agreement. I will have my records available when I meet with my advisor.
