



### Outcome Assessment:

Evaluation of the student's understanding of managerial accounting will primarily involve homework, workshops using case book, examinations, and classroom participation. Homework will be used to evaluate computer skills and written communications. Team work will be evaluated through a team case study problem. Discussion of homework will be used to evaluate oral communication skills, and projects will be used to evaluate computer skills.

### Attendance:

Attendance and participation in class are key components to learning and understanding managerial accounting material. Rather than taking attendance, quizzes will be given at random both to reward those who attend and to help you evaluate your understanding of the concepts.

### Homework and Assignments:

Homework assignments are listed on the following page. Students must complete all homework assignments in Excel. Handwritten homework will not be accepted. Some homework problems have Excel templates available at [www.mhhe.com/brewer4e](http://www.mhhe.com/brewer4e). It is okay to use these templates. In fact they are usually helpful.
